- d) 39th Annual MCRCSIP Workshop and Membership Meeting is July 19-20 at the Soaring Eagle.

Public Comment was received at this time from Christoper Vogt and Pam Nagel, residents of Greenwood Township. They were asking about dust control. Mielke Way is very dusty, and the boat launch and beach are in the middle of the horseshoe-shaped road. They were not notified by the township that they had opted out of the dust control. They attended a Greenwood township meeting and convinced them to opt back in for the next application. Mr. Vogt wanted to know if anyone had done research on alternatives. Manager Defour explained that we do bid it out, so we had the lowest price. Other methods of dust control are much more expensive. Ms. Nagel asked if they could obtain the services of another company, would we still pay our third. Manager Defour assured her we would, provided that it all went through the township.

A County Commissioner's Report was received at this time from Tom McCauley. He said that they interviewed six people for the motor pool position, and they have narrowed it down to two. Sheriff Grace and the ambulance director will do second interviews and make a recommendation.

a) MCRCSIP 2023 Board of Directors Election – There is one at large candidate, and for the other two positions there are four candidates. Steve recommended they vote for Tony Casali of Isabella County and Brent Shank of Emmet County.
